Parent Responsibilities and Student Code of Conduct

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. As parents, you are the primary source of learning for your child(ren).
2. Each family is responsible for filling two volunteer positions within Agape per year. (Records only exempt)
3. At least one parent must attend monthly parent meetings. 1st monthly meeting will be held on the 1st Thursday of August. Subsequent meetings will be on the 1st Thursday of each month. (Records only exempt)
4. Fees must be paid on time as indicated on the current fee schedule.
5. K-8th Course descriptions are due at the September meeting. 9th–12th Course descriptions are due by October 1st. A \$25 late fee will be charged per family per month.
6. Parents are responsible for quarterly grades for K-8th grades and semester grades for 9th-12th. Due dates will be posted on the web site for the current year. A \$25 late fee will be charged per family per month.
7. Attendance forms are due the 1st of each month for the previous month. A \$25 late fee will be charged per family per month if not received by the 5th of the month. Directions for filing attendance are on the web site, under 'forms'.
8. Each family is responsible for maintaining current HSLDA membership. Proof required by September meeting. You can sign-up at HSLDA.org. Agape discount code will be provided after registration is completed.
9. Each family is asked to remember that their conduct reflects on our school. This includes conduct at school and in the community as well as social media.

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of Agape Academy's Student Code of Conduct is to promote a Christ-like attitude and to encourage positive Christian relationships among our students and their families. While conduct during Agape events is our primary concern, we reserve the right to address non-school related conduct as needed if it affects relationships within our families or our reputation as a Christian school.
